The 2008 South Australian Junior Heifer Expo is fast approaching. The committee are working hard to plan another action packed event.

This year for the first time, all entrants will be provided with a **Heifer Expo Polo Shirt** as part of their entry fee, and an Auction of cattle products will take place on the Thursday between the Handler Judging and Animal Championships.

Please note that you don't have to have your own animal to participate. Provided you contact the Co-ordinator and send your entry form in on time, the SAJHE committee can arrange an animal for you to borrow. Competitors will be split into age-based groups for the entire period of SAJHE.

Participants must stay on the grounds to receive the most from their SAJHE experience. On Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday nights a security guard will be hired and adult supervision of the designated sleeping areas will be rostered. However, the committee will not become policemen after programmed activities have finished. Parents are welcome to stay on the grounds.

ALL FOOD for participants is included in the SAJHE entry fee. Lunches will be provided for the entrants as well as breakfast and dinner. (For any parents and friends wishing to attend the dinner a fee of \$5.00 per head will be charged.)

S A JUNIOR HEIFER EXPO



The South Australian Junior Heifer Expo is the largest and most successful junior beef industry educational event in Australia and is now in its third decade of operation. The concept and establishment of the Expo was the initiative of a dedicated and visionary group of South Australian beef cattle producers, who recognised the potential long and short-term benefits of such an event. These breeders felt the future of the Australian beef industry would be enhanced through the education and encouragement of our youth to become active, constructive and enthusiastic participants within the industry. The inaugural Expo was staged in 1985 and from humble beginnings it has grown to its present status. The average participation rate is now around 150 junior community members per year ranging from 8 to 23 years of age. Over 2850 have entered this event since its beginning. They have come from all states of Australia as well as New Zealand. The major annual award at the Expo is a scholarship for a four month study tour of North America, which is awarded to the Senior Champion Herdsman. This acts as a huge incentive, enticing many participants to return year after year. As testimonial to the events original objective, a large number of the participants have gone on to take up very prominent and responsible positions within the beef industry and the community in general.

Participants are required to have a heifer or steer that they work with over the 3 days of the event. A supply network assists those who do not have immediate access to a suitable animal. Expo participants and their livestock are accommodated at the Adelaide Showground at Wayville, during the event, to undertake the full and comprehensive program. This along with responsible leaders and the age variation "buddy" system ensures participants gain maximum benefit from their participation. Besides the educational benefits, numerous lifelong friendships have been established as a direct result of meeting at this Expo.

The main objective is to encourage livestock enthusiasts to gain knowledge and skills in the many facets of the cattle industry.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



1. Entrants to be between 8 and 23 years inclusive as at 30.6.2008.
2. Entrants are **NOT** required to be a financial member of any Breed Society.
3. Each entrant may exhibit **ONE HEIFER OR STEER** only and the committee reserves the right to utilize any animal for the educational program.
4. All heifers must be registered with their relevant Breed Society. All steers must state breed or percentages of breeds.
5. Heifers eligible for entry - born between 1.9.06 and 1.10.07 (9 to 22 months). Steers must have milk teeth only and weigh over 280kg.
6. Heifers to be judged on an Interbreed basis, and divided into classes upon receipt of entries. Steers to be judged as steers on feed (to be slaughtered in approximately 40 days) on an Interbreed basis divided into classes upon weighing.
7. All exhibits must have an acceptable temperament and be broken to lead. Any Exhibitors found administering sedatives to their animal will face immediate disqualification. Steers must be dehorned and properly castrated. Steers must not be treated with HGP.
8. **All exhibits during the Show must be totally attended and prepared by the exhibitor ONLY.** For Exhibitors up to the age of 12 years, or novice entrants, minimal assistance will be tolerated.
No adult assistance or outside professional assistance will be tolerated.
9. **Nose clips must be used at all times when cattle are being led and neck straps are compulsory when cattle are in the shed. The committee reserves the right to deal with any situation or incident that arises.**
10. Exhibitors to supply own Cattle Feed, Hay nets should be provided by exhibitor due to John's requirement, feed bins, water buckets and equipment, wash hoses with 12mm fittings. Padlocks for lockers **MUST** have 2 keys minimum. (*Padlocks available for purchase from L.G. Matten on showgrounds*)
11. Individual Breed Societies will be responsible for inspection of all animal tattoos, and/or firebrands prior to Judging. If incorrect, absent or illegible the animal will be disqualified. If animal disqualified - Handler of that animal is automatically disqualified.
12. **RINGWORM** - any animal found infected with ringworm prior to the Heifer Show can still be brought to the Showground provided that a Veterinary Certificate is produced on arrival stating that the veterinarian has seen the animals treated and/or washed in the last 4 days with an appropriate fungicide. Further washing to take place at the Showground under supervision of Committee member.
13. **HANDLERS AGES - as at 30.06.08**
Junior Section - 8 to 11 yrs, Sub-Intermediate 12 to 14 yrs, Intermediate Section - 15 to 17 yrs, Senior Section - 18 to 23 yrs inclusive
14. **All exhibitors must live on grounds. Official permission must be obtained to leave grounds.** An Attendant will be on duty at the Goodwood Road - Leader Street Gate until 10.00 pm after which the gates will be locked. Any visitors attending the Dinners will be requested to leave by 10.00 pm.
15. Alcohol may be consumed by persons over 18 years of age in the designated barbecue area only, for the duration of the evening meal. No alcohol is to be kept or consumed in any other area or at any other time.
16. Disruptive and/or unacceptable behavior from entrants will not be tolerated and the Committee has the power to take whatever action is deemed necessary to deal with behavioral problems.
17. A Security Officer will be on duty at the Showground for the duration of the Heifer Show.
18. **ENTRY FEE - \$150.00 (fee includes GST and sawdust cost).** (This charge also covers both Handler and Heifer Entry Fee, ALL MEALS throughout the Show and use of locker.)
19. **All electrical appliances** must be in sound working order and safety tagged. The use of double adaptors is strictly prohibited. Competitors to supply their own "Safety Switch" (RCD) for installation at each power outlet they use.
20. **HEALTH STATUS** - If the herd status for EBL is infected or provisionally clear all animals entered must be tested negative within 90 days of the opening of the Show. Documentation of negative results must be submitted to the Expo Council at least 14 days before commencement of the Expo. **If the herd status for John's Disease is infected or suspect, entries will not be accepted.**
21. **PIC NUMBER MUST APPEAR ON THE ENTRY FORM.**
22. **INSURANCE AND PUBLIC LIABILITY** is the responsibility of the Owner/Exhibitor. Any private vehicles parked within the Showgrounds will be totally at the risk of the Owner.
23. Management and control of the Junior Heifer Expo will be in the hands of the Council and their decision shall be final. Any complaints concerning the Junior Heifer Expo or applications for refunds will only be accepted in writing, and will be resolved by the Council at the August 2008 meeting.
24. **Any exhibitor not conforming to any regulations faces immediate disqualification from the event.**

CATERING

ALL FOOD for participants is included in the SAJHE entry fee. (For any parents and friends wishing to attend the dinner a fee of \$5.00 per head will be charged.) Adult assistance is greatly appreciated at these times

LOCKERS

Lockers (1.5X1.8M) are automatically provided for all entrants. Two entrants will share a locker. For specific locker requests please complete the attached form.

IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT A BED AND/OR MATTRESS AND WARM BEDDING ARE PROVIDED BY OCCUPANT.

CLOTHING

WARM AND WATERPROOF CLOTHING IS ESSENTIAL.

MEDICATION

Please be aware that the committee cannot administer analgesics eg. Panadol, to participants. If they are required they will need to be supplied by the entrant or parent.

PARENTS / GUARDIANS / TEACHERS

The Council requests that parents especially of younger children give consideration to "living-in" at the Showground for the duration of the Expo. Cost is \$50 per person to cover the cost of meals. PARENTS HELP WITH SUPERVISION, PARTICULARLY DURING THE EVENINGS AND AT NIGHT-TIME WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED. Parents are accommodated in general sleeping areas however lockers may be utilised if required (depending on availability)

STOCK ENTRY TO SHOWGROUND

Due to safety reasons, large barriers will be erected by the RA&HS of SA Inc., and all cattle must be unloaded within the barriers. No exceptions. Trucks, trailers, horse floats to line-up outside the Beef Cattle Pavilion.

Entry will be via the Leader Street Entrance from 12 noon until 4pm Monday 14th July (committee excluded). Please notify your carrier.

HEIFERS/STEERS - BEDDING ARRANGEMENTS

Sawdust is supplied. Please bring appropriate tools for mucking out, e.g. rakes, shovels, fine tine forks, brooms.

The quick removal of manure will ensure that the sawdust will last the full show. Do not dig out wet patches. Do not disturb the bedding base.

JOHNE'S DISEASE MANAGEMENT

The use of hay nets is highly recommended

Keep shed aisles and wash bay free from faeces

Do not tether or feed animals outside in uncontrolled areas.

Accredited animals are to have their feet hosed off before returning to stalls.

NO CLIPPING SHUTES TO BE ERECTED

All animals are expected to be prepared prior to coming to the Expo. Senior Herdsman, are exempted, as this is part of their criteria for entry.

HEIFER EXPO MANUAL

The Heifer Expo Manual will be placed in the satchels for Novice entrants.

INTERSTATE EXHIBITORS

You are welcome to stay overnight on the 17th July, following the completion of the Expo, if desired.

You will however, be required to depart early on Friday morning, to allow the sheds to be cleaned.

Exhibitors, families and friends are reminded of the enormous task undertaken by a small group of Committee members and helpers each year to set up judging arena and surrounds, compile satchels for entrants, and assist with general preparations for the Expo

CLEAN -UP THURSDAY 17th JULY

All entrants are expected to ensure that their cattle stall, loft above cattle, and lockers are left clean and tidy. **ALL** sawdust is to be placed in appropriate bins. Rubbish should be put in bins. Senior entrants are requested to assist the Committee with the shed and arena clean up prior to their departure.

Please note that no competitor is to leave the grounds unless official permission has been granted.
